November 2009 marked the opening of Kia's new one-billion dollar, 2,259-acre automotive engineering and manufacturing plant in West Point, Georgia. The state-of-the-art facility is the first plant in North America for Kia, with a capacity to produce 300,000 cars annually* and marks the largest foreign investment in the history of the state of Georgia.

For Kia, the Georgia plant is a natural step in our growing success in the United States. It is an investment in America and demonstrates the ongoing commitment of excellence to those who drive a Kia. The plant is built on the three principles that guide KMMG: quality, flexibility and productivity.
